### LABOR RATES

Standard Ellis Service Rate ..... \$75/hr

## VESSEL STORAGE

Sept to July \* - Includes blocking and stands.

\$4.00 per sq. ft. outdoor storage. \*\*  
\$10.50 per sq. ft. inside storage on dirt floor.  
\$12.50 per sq. ft. indoor heated storage.  
Tender/Dinghy = \$125

*\* Flexible haul and launch dates. The full storage fee will be billed in the Fall/Winter. No refunds or discounts are given for late-season arrival or early departure. Additional yard fees may occur if you leave your boat at our facility over the entire boating season. \*\* All shrink-wrapping billed separately. We may not recommend shrink-wrapping certain vessels.*

## TYPICAL STORAGE MAINTENANCE

### FALL (when applicable):

- Pick up and inventory
- Fill fuel tanks with treated fuel
- Pump and winterize holding tank
- Haul and set up for winter storage
- Power wash bottom
- Clean exterior and interior
- Decommission, winterize and survey
- Recommend work based on survey
- Clean/decommission/winterize dinghy

### SPRING (when applicable):

- Move from storage and/or uncover
- Clean interior; clean, buff and wax exterior
- Patch minor scratches
- Refinish guards and rails (PVC)
- Clean and polish hardware
- Commission
- Seasonal oil or varnish
- Paint bottom and boot stripe
- Clean and commission dinghy
- Launch, sea trial & deliver

### MOORING USAGE:

- In an effort to minimize moorage and dockage fees, we will do our best to haul or launch your boat as close to your delivery date as possible.
- We recommend inspecting all in-the-water boats at least twice a week. We can provide this service for a minimal fee.

### NOTES:

- Visitors are always welcome at Ellis Boat Company. We ask that all visitors report to the main office before entering the shop, service or storage buildings.
- Ellis Boat Company, Inc. does not insure boats in storage. Owners are responsible for their own boat insurance.
